

WHAT TO WEAR

While the focus of the session is your pet, your clothing is important too!

Layers - layers always add interest, even in fine weather, so think hats, belts, scarves, ties, layered shirts and tees, jackets, vests, etc.

Textures/Patterns - textures create interest and depth in images, but too many patterns can be distracting, so use cautiously.

Colors - no need to stick to neutrals, but try working from the same color palette while not being afraid of a splash of something bright!

What to avoid - lots of black and white, or too many strong colors like hot pink/magenta or bright green, do not photograph well. Don't choose hats that cast a strong shadow on the face, like baseball caps. And be careful with transition lenses which can change frequently in unstable lighting.
